In any given year at McGill Law...




1100 + Refused candidates

Due to Lack of space, we refuse many candidates with positive elements




8:1 Applications to class size ratio





WHAT GOES IN A NEW APPLICATION



New Personal Statement

Must stand alone. Do not assume that the Committee will reread the old one.

New limit of 750 words.





Ce qu'il faut soumettre dans une

nouvelle demande d'admission

New CV
Maximum 2 pages





Assistant Dean will have access to old file, but don't presume that she will read it in its entirety.







It depends:

Were the old ones final? Were they all academic?

You can re-use the same ones, but you must re-submit them via the Applicant Portal
