


Proof of Quebec Residency for Situation 6

1 - Submit one of the following:

- A copy of your property tax bill
- A copy of your school tax bill
- A copy of the lease for your apartment rental
 - If the lease has expired; a copy of the expired lease along with a letter from the landlord confirming that the lease has been renewed.
- In some cases a lease may not have been issued in your name, i.e. you moved in with family or roommates. In this case a letter from the building landlord is required to substantiate your address and the occupancy dates at that address. The landlord's name, address and contact information should be clearly indicated on this letter. You are also required to submit a copy of the lease issued to the original tenant(s).
- Where a student lives in a house that does not belong to him/her, a letter from the homeowner along with a copy of a municipal tax bill or mortgage statement where the owner's name and address is clearly indicated on the bill are acceptable as proof of domicile. The letter from the homeowner should indicate the student's name and the dates of occupancy.

Quebec lease



Key elements for your lease

Must be a complete Régie du logement lease (e.g. all four pages of document are required).

You must be a signatory to the lease.

The effective dates of lease must cover the full 12 month reference period.

If the lease does not cover the full 12 month reference period, also provide a letter from your landlord (signed, and on letterhead or featuring contact information for landlord) indicating the dates for which you have resided at the address stipulated in your lease.


2 – You must also submit:

Two pieces of official correspondence addressed to the person applying for Quebec residency. The date should be clearly indicated on the mailings submitted and should be dated within the one year reference period.

Acceptable correspondence* includes:

- Public service invoice.
- Correspondence from driver's license bureau.
- Official correspondence from a municipal, provincial or federal government.
- Official correspondence from a financial institution
- Correspondence from an educational institution other than McGill University

Key elements for your mailings

Name on mailing matches name stipulated in domicile documentation (e.g. lease)

Issued to the address substantiated by the supporting lease.
