Laptop connection to Crestron system	Laptop shows video, but no picture appears on projection screen  Laptop and projection screen show video, but no sound is playing	<ol> <li>Mac or PC laptops</li> <li>Check Crestron touchscreen: un-toggle "Video Mute"</li> <li>Try switching connection buttons between VGA (sometimes labelled RGB) and HDMI/DVI</li> <li>Restart Crestron system [Red "Home" button &gt; Shut Down]</li> <li>Check the laptop projection display settings:         <ul> <li>Mac laptops: Go to System Preferences &gt; Displays</li> <li>Mirrored displays = what you see on the laptop should be the same as what is projected</li> <li>PC laptops: Go to Settings &gt; System &gt; Displays</li> <li>Duplicate displays = what you see on the laptop should be the same as what is projected</li> <li>Mac or PC laptops:</li></ul></li></ol>
