- An average B+ grade (program GPA of 3.3) is required to maintain Honours standing in Linguistics and a minimum grade of B+ must be obtained in three out of four of the following courses: LING 330, LING 331, LING 360, LING 371, as well as in the Honours Thesis.
- A grade of “C” or better must be obtained in all courses for your program (both required and complementary).
- A single course can only count towards **one** program; if there is course overlap between programs, speak with your departmental advisor.
- Required courses must be completed at McGill, not abroad. Please plan accordingly.
- Check course prerequisites before you register for a course.

* Any Statistics course can be chosen from any department.

** Any Language course can be chosen, other than a course in the student’s native language. Literature courses are not acceptable.
