The following is a summary of the Senate meeting which took place on October 19, 2022.

The meeting began with Dean Eidelman presenting a memorial tributes for Professor Emerita Barbara Jones Galaty, Professor Ronald Gottesman, and Professor Maxime Bouchard. Senate adopted the minutes of the last Senate meeting

In his remarks from the Chair, Acting Principal Manfredi noted the recent Quebec provincial election and indicated that McGill looks forward to working with the new Minister of Higher Education. The Principal also summarized two new university rankings. For the 18th consecutive year, McGill placed 1st in the Medical/Doctoral category of the annual Maclean's rankings. McGill ranked in the top three in nine of 12 performance indicators. The Times Higher Education World University Rankings 2023 rates McGill as the 46th best university in the world. It marks the 13th consecutive year that McGill ranks in the top 50 universities globally.

There were two items under the agenda item for written questions.
