Senate Report, 2022-11-16

Colleagues,

The following is a summary of the Senate meeting which took place on November 16, 2022.

The meeting began with Senator Snider presenting memorial tributes for Professors Emeriti Sylvia Cruess, Donald Lawrence, and Garth Bray. In his remarks from the Chair, Acting Principal Manfredi thanked the members of the Advisory Committee for the Selection of the Principal for their work. As was announced a few days ago, the Board of Governors has approved the appointment of Professor H. Deep Saini as the 18th Principal and Vice-Chancellor of McGill University. Professor Saini will begin his five-year, renewable term at McGill on April 1, 2023, and he will also hold the appointment of Full Professor in the Faculty of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences. Regarding government relations, the McGill Administration will be meeting Quebec's new Minister of Higher Education, Pascale Déry, later this month to discuss priority issues, including funding. Principal Manfredi recently attended a meeting of the Association of American Universities, of which McGill and University of Toronto are the only Canadian members; McGill will need to pay close attention to its status within the AAU, whose advocacy activities are being reconceptualized towards lobbying for American universities.
