Senate Report, 2023-02-15

Colleagues,

The following is a summary of the Senate meeting which took place on February 15, 2023.

In his remarks from the Chair, Acting Principal Manfredi noted the McGill community's sadness at the recent passing of Marcel Desautels, who generously donated both his resources and his time to furthering business education at McGill. The University flag will be lowered in early March in commemoration. There will be active Tri-Council and Universities Canada involvement in the current development of security guidelines for university research. This year's edition of the McGill24 digital fundraising campaign will be held on March 15, 2023.
