Senate Report, 2023-05-10

Colleagues,

The following is a summary of the Senate meeting which took place on May 10, 2023.

Principal Saini opened the meeting by thanking the Senators whose terms are ending for their service and contributions. Dean Eidelman presented a memorial tributes for Professor Emeritus Charles Scriver.

In a point of business arising from the April minutes, regarding the proposed Policy on Academic Freedom, it was indicated that the presentation slides have been added onto the online document for this item <u>https://www.mcgill.ca/senate/files/senate/d22-60 proposed policy on academic freedom updated.pdf</u> and that a note to this effect has been added to the minutes.

In his remarks from the Chair, Principal Saini summarized the April 28 announcement by the federal Minister of Innovation, Science and Industry, François-Philippe Champagne, of \$1.4 billion in support of 11 large-scale research initiatives through the Canada First Research Excellence Fund, including a \$165 million CFREF grant to McGill to launch a genomic-based RNA therapeutics research effort. The Principal gave an overview of his attendance at the recent U15 and Universities Canada meetings, and discussed the Quebec's Superior Court's ratification on April 20 of an agreement between the Kanien'kehá:ka Kahnistensera (Mohawk Mothers), McGill University, the Société québécoise des infrastructures (SQI), the MUHC, the City of Montreal and the Attorneys General of Quebec and Canada that will allow an archaeological investigation of the former Royal Victoria Hospital site to move forward. Details about the forthcoming Convocation ceremonies, and the Principal's Installation, as well as livestream links for these events, will be sent out soon to the McGill community. Principal Saini congratulated Dr. Lesley Fellows for her appointment as Vice-Principal (Health Affairs) and Dean of the Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences, which will begin on August 1, and thanked Dean David Eidelman for his service in this role. The Principal also thanked Dean of Engineering Jim Nicell, who is attending his last Senate meeting in this capacity.
