The following is a summary of the Senate meeting which took place on October 18, 2023.

The meeting began with Dean Lennox presenting memorial tributes for Professor Emeritus John F. Harrod and Professor Emeritus Isztar Zawadski, and with Dean Yargeau presenting a memorial tribute for Professor Patrick Selvadurai.

In his comments from the Chair, Principal Saini spoke about the conflict in Israel and Gaza, a subject which he addressed in his recent email to the McGill community. He noted that the situation is an extremely difficult one involving great suffering and loss of life, and he called upon everyone to be extra considerate towards each other during the weeks ahead. He also discussed the measures impacting university financing which were announced by the Quebec government, a topic about which he has provided additional information to the McGill community by email. McGill is deeply disappointed by the government's new policy, and is actively exploring various means to ensure that McGill remains accessible. The latest Maclean's Magazine ranking of Canadian universities has been released, and for 19th consecutive year McGil ranked first in the medical / doctoral universities category.
