Senate Report, 2023-12-06

Colleagues,

The following is a summary of the Senate meeting which took place on December 6, 2023.

The session began with Senate observing a minute of silence in memory of the 14 women who were murdered and the 14 others who were injured at Polytechnique Montréal on December 6, 1989.

Memorial tributes were presented by Dean Lennox for Professor Emeritus Douglas Stairs and Professor Emeritus Byung Chan Eu. The scheduled memorial tribute for Professor Jerry Pelletier was postponed until the next Senate meeting.

Senate adopted the report of the Steering

In his comments from the Chair, Principal Saini provided an update on the provincial government's plans to change funding and tuition at Quebec universities. Discussions with the government are ongoing, but an announcement about a final decision is expected in the near future, possibly even within a day or so.

Senate approved Section I and discussed Section II, the latter being a set of proposed revisions to the Regulation on Conflict of Interest and to its companion document on recognizing such conflicts (see Appendix C of the report). The revised documents are expected to return to Senate for approval in January.
