Students may register for no more than 5 courses per semester, but no less than 4 courses per semester (unless approved to do so by their home university).
Credit System	The basic unit of academic work is a semester course. Unless otherwise specified each semester course, successfully completed, equals three (3) credits, i.e. 39 hours (undergraduate degrees) and 36 hours (graduate degree) of teaching which may include lecture, laboratory/tutorials.
Housing/Accommodation	On-campus accommodations are available for all exchange students. Request for on-campus housing is done on the application form for the exchange programme. When applying for admission, students must indicate their Hall of preference.
