


NON-STOP DISCOVERY



Tel Aviv University (TAU) is Israel's largest and most comprehensive institution of higher learning. It is home to over 1,200 researchers and 30,000 students, organized in nine faculties and over 125 schools and departments across a spectrum of sciences, humanities, and the arts.

Courses and Programs

TAU offers over a large variety of courses in different faculties and departments, in English. Exchange students have the flexibility to choose from a diverse course list, though some may be subject to pre-requisites and availability.

In addition, discounted Hebrew language courses are available for students to immerse in modern-day Hebrew but also gain insight into Israeli daily culture and history. Arabic language studies are also offered to our exchange students, included in the tuition fee.

Grading System

TAU Scale of Grades

95-100	Excellent
85–94	Very Good
75–84	Good
65–74	Fairly Good
60	Lowest Passing Grade

Each course is normally worth 2-4 credits.

A two-credit course is equivalent to a 90-minute class each week for the academic semester. The normal course load at Tel-Aviv University is between 6-9 courses for one semester (15-20 TAU credits).

For students who enroll in Study Abroad Courses, one 45 min course is equivalent to 1 credit point.

The conversion rate for ECTS to TAU credits is 2:1 (2 ECTS are equal to 1 TAU credit).

PRE-DEPARTURE INFORMATION

Housing

While housing is not guaranteed, TAU does offer on and off-campus housing in a number of different housing complexes.

Living spaces at TAU are furnished and contain a kitchenette, bathroom, WIFI and AC.

Living Expenses

The cost of living (COA) in Tel Aviv depends on a number of considerations, from lifestyle choices, location and housing type, and transportation.

Students can expect to pay \$750-900 USD/month for groceries and household supplies, based on an estimation of 3 meals per day and provided that the majority of meals are cooked/eaten at home.

TAU is located in Ramat Aviv, a northern neighborhood of the city of Tel Aviv, and is a quick ride away from all the action in central Tel Aviv. Getting around and to and from Tel Aviv is fairly straightforward.

A monthly bus pass starts at \$63 USD/month.

Depending on the preferred mode of transportation, campus is accessible by bus, train, bike, and even electric scooter!

Health Insurance

For the safety and security of our students, we do require that all students be covered by Health Insurance while studying in Israel. Not only is this part of the visa requirements set by the Ministry of Interior Affairs, but it is part of our University regulations. Students may either get insurance from back home, or check our website for comprehensive information on the types of health insurance students can purchase, as well as cost and contact information.

Visas

The student visa is a multiple-entry A2 visa (making it possible to leave Israel for a vacation and return without requiring a new visa). It is mandatory that all students participating in programs of one semester or longer secure a student visa before arriving in Israel. The visa is valid for up to one year and must be renewed thereafter.
