Immigration Supplement – FALL 2024 ADMISSION

This document is a supplement to the letter of offer for a student position in Faculty of Medicine of McGill University for immigration purposes. A copy of this document can be found at www.mcgill.ca/medadmissions/newstudents/registration-orientation/international-students

International students (students requiring a study permit to study in Canada) must obtain a Certificat d'acceptation du Québec (CAQ) from Immigration Québec and a Study Permit from Citizenship and Immigration Canada. When applying for your Student Permit with Canada, you will also need to apply for a "co-op work permit" as the M.D.,C.M. program has required clinical rotations not comprising more than 50% of the program credits. All students must complete these clinical courses in order to obtain the M.D.,C.M. degree. Detailed immigration procedures are provided on the International Students Services website at www.mcgill.ca/internationalstudents/. Immigration officials require a copy of the admission letter along with a copy of this supplement to provide an estimate of the cost and duration of the studies.

Program: M.D.,C.M.

International students admitted to the **Doctor of Medicine and Master of Surgery** (M.D.,C.M.) program of the Faculty of Medicine of McGill University should expect the following approximate annual cost:

*First year fees are greater with certain one-time charges.

The M.D.,C.M. program is a four year program, only offered full-time and runs in an academic year of August to June.
