



MEDICINE: CANADIAN (NON-QUEBEC) RESIDENT

Overview

An applicant is eligible to apply as a member of this category if he or she **(a)** is a Canadian citizen or permanent resident of Canada who is not a resident of Québec, **(b)** will have obtained an undergraduate (Bachelor's) degree before July 31 of the entering year of medicine and **(c)** adheres to all other admission requirements and conditions for medical programs.

Applicants in this category can apply to the MDCM or MDCM & PhD programs. Because both programs have MDCM as a foundation, applicants need only submit one application to their preferred program. There is no quota for joint program applications.

French Language Proficiency

French-language proficiency is a pre-admission requirement for students starting the MDCM Program. The French-language minimum requirements are a **B2 (mid-intermediate)** level for the Montreal Campus.

Requirement exemptions:

- Candidates who have completed **both** high school and CEGEP in **Quebec** (in English or French) will not be required to submit proof of French-language proficiency.
- Candidates who have completed **at least 1 year** of secondary or post-secondary study at an institution whose **official** language of instruction is **French**.
- Candidates who wrote **CASPer** (score used for admission to medicine) in French do **not** need to submit proof of French-language proficiency

Special Note

Canadian (Non-Quebec) residents will be placed at the Montreal campus only.
