- / Significant involvement in faculty development activities at a faculty or departmental
- level. Research and Scholarly Activity in

Education;

- ✓ Demonstration of a scholarly approach to teaching and education.
- Research in the area of health professions/ sciences education.
- ✓ Grants received for health professions/ sciences education.



FACULTY HONOUR LIST SYMPOSIUM

All individuals named to the Faculty Honour List will be invited to attend the Symposium, which is held in the Spring of each year. This symposium will include presentations by the honourees, who will be asked to discuss their areas of interest, leadership, or innovation in education. Individuals will be honoured at a reception following the symposium.

NOMINATING PROCESS

Individuals who have been faculty members for <u>at</u> <u>least five years</u> can be nominated to the Faculty Honour List by their peers, students, or supervisors.

A faculty committee, appointed by the Dean, will select the honourees according to the elements in the recognized areas of achievement.
