Larynx, trachea, and bronchi, stenosis and atrasia in congenital syphilis.

The breathing channels showing short deformed epiglottism, cicatricial ulceration with stenosis of larynx, stenosis of trachea, occlusion of trachea by scar. Cicatricial contraction of bronchi. Tracheotomy wound with opaque red passing into bronchus.
