SACCULAR ANEURYSM.

M.G.H. P.M. 567 Presented by Dr. Osler, 1879 E.124

Large saccular aneurysm of ascending aorta with secondary sacculations and tupture of one of these into the wight pleura. Diffuse dilatation of aorta to the end of transverse arch. Syphilitic aortitis.

Male, age 43. Dyspnoea, brassy cough, precordial pain some time. Pulsation to right of sternum. Heavy treatment with wx potassium iodide four months, but no lamination of sac

resulted.
