

SACCULAR ANEURYSM.

Presented by Dr. Osler, 1879

Large saccular aneurysm of ascending aorta with secondary sacculations and rupture of one of these into the right pleura. Diffuse dilatation of aorta to the end of transverse arch. Syphilitic aortitis.

Male, age 43. Dyspnoea, brassy cough, precordial pain some time. Pulsation to right of sternum. Heavy treatment with ~~ix~~ potassium iodide four months, but no lamination of sac resulted.
