

SACCULAR ANEURYSM.

Saccular aneurysm of the thoracic aorta eroding the bodies of the dorsal vertebrae and forming a false aneurysm. Pressure on the left bronchus.

Adult male; acute pleurisy two years before. Pain in left chest and dyspnoea since then. Tracheal tugging. Neuralgia 5th., 6th., and 7th., intercostals. Heaving pulsation about xyphoid cartilage. Died with increasing asphyxia.
