





## "An academic journey from Medical Physics to AI4Health: From diving to surfing research, and back again"

In this presentation, I would like to share how my experience at the MPU led me to the broader research domain of applied artificial intelligence for health (AI4Health). I will also present the activities of my research laboratory based on the central theme of "Modeling heterogeneous healthcare data for developing risk models" and divided under three main research axes: (i) Quantitative medical image analysis; (ii) Heterogenous data modeling; and (iii) Federated learning.
