

## Fellowship Descriptions

**Attention to all our postdoctoral applicants and supervisors, due to the changes made by the government of Quebec as of January 2017 and unionization of Postdoctoral fellows, award amount will be subject to the assessment of applicable taxes and benefit rates required by payroll regulations. Supervisors are responsible to top-up successful applicants if the award amount is less than the required minimum (\$34,100 as of June 1, 2019) as per the collective agreement.**

### Conrad F. Harrington Fellowship

Established in 1999 in honour of Conrad F. Harrington in recognition of his leadership in developing the McGill University Health Centre. The Postdoctoral Fellowship in the area of **amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (ALS)** will support researchers who have received their M.D. or Ph.D. degrees and who wish to advance their research careers in the Faculty of Medicine in the McGill University Health Centre. In the event that there are no candidates investigating ALS, the Fellowship will be awarded to support a postdoctoral candidate working in a related area of **neurological disease**. Awarded by the Postgraduate Award Committee of the Faculty of Medicine. Value: \$15,000

### Dr. David T.W. Lin Fellowship

Established in 1998 by a generous gift from a McGill graduate of Chemical Engineering (Class of 1959), from Hong Kong, in recognition of Dr. David T.W. Lin, B.Sc. 1937, M.D., C.M. 1940, a surgeon emeritus at the Royal Victoria Hospital, to support medical research. Awarded by the Postgraduate Awards Committee of the Faculty of Medicine to a student at the Postdoctoral, Ph.D. or M.Sc. level. Value: \$17,000

### McLaughlin Fellowship

Established by the R. Samuel McLaughlin Foundation for Postdoctoral Fellowships for individuals with an M.D. or Ph.D. degree and who are undertaking research within the McGill University Faculty of Medicine or affiliated hospitals. The Fellowship will be awarded for one year, by the Postgraduate Awards Committee of the Faculty of Medicine. The recipient is eligible to re-enter the competition for a second year of support. Value: \$21,500

### Peter Quinlan Fellowship in Oncology

To honour the memory of Peter Quinlan, a fellowship fund has been established in his name by his family and friends. The Peter Quinlan Fellowship will support young researchers (M.D. or Ph.D.) who wish to undertake postdoctoral training in **oncology** at McGill University and its affiliated hospitals under the direction of a member of the Faculty of Medicine. The Fellowship will be awarded by the Postgraduate Awards Committee of the Faculty of Medicine for one year, but the recipient is eligible to re-enter the competition for a second year of support. Value: \$34,000

### Richard and Edith Strauss Postdoctoral Fellowships in Medicine

The Richard and Edith Strauss Postdoctoral Fellowships in Medicine will recognize and promote research in the areas of **stem cell and regenerative medicine, chronic disease and aging**. Fellowships will support Postdoctoral researchers at McGill University and will be awarded annually by the Faculty of Medicine Postgraduate Awards Committee (PGAC), with no citizenship requirement. Each Fellowship may be renewed once upon favorable recommendation from the supervisor(s) and evaluation by PGAC of a 3-page report, indicating progress and future directions, submitted by the recipient. Value: \$32,000 + \$2,000 for travel or research related expenses, renewable once.

### **The Rosenberg/Ungar/Schwarzbard/Kallchman Hematology Research**

Established by Irene Ungar in memory of her mother Tammy Rosenberg Ungar and her sister Sandy Rosenberg Schwarzhard Kalichman, is open to both doctoral and post-doctoral applicants in any department in the Faculty of Medicine specifically for **Hematology research**. Applications will be evaluated by the Postgraduate Awards Committee (PGAC) and awarded by the Faculty of Medicine. This award is for one year. Preference will be given to a female candidate. Value: \$34,000

### **Ferring Pharmaceuticals Postdoctoral Fellowship in Health**

Established in 2016 by Ferring Pharmaceuticals in support of one or more outstanding Postdoctoral Fellows pursuing research in the areas of **Reproductive Health (including Obstetrics, Labour and Delivery, Maternal and Neonate/Child Health), Urology including Ure-oncology, Orthopedics/Orthobiologics, Gastroenterology or Endocrinology**. Awarded by the Postgraduate Awards Committee (PGAC) of the Faculty of Medicine. Each Fellowship may be renewed upon satisfactory progress. Value: \$42,500 plus \$8,000 for research related costs; renewable once.
