



MIMM MERIT FELLOWSHIPS FOR Ph.D. 5 and Ph.D. 6 STUDENTS

The Department of Microbiology & Immunology receives endowments bequeathed to McGill University by the late DR. FRANCIS CHARLES HARRISON (1870-1952) and the late DR. JACOB ROZANIS. Dr. Rozanis received his Ph.D. at McGill in 1967. The Department of MIMM also receives an allocation from the Faculty of Medicine for Graduate Excellence Fellowships (GEFs). These funds are to be used for graduate student fellowships.

Value: The Graduate Program Committee of the Department of Microbiology and Immunology will award discretionary annual bursaries to deserving Ph.D. 5 and Ph.D. 6 candidates registered in the Department. The number and amount of the fellowships will depend on the amount of funds available.

Eligibility: Only Ph.D. 5 and Ph.D. 6 students registered full-time are eligible for these awards. These fellowships will be awarded on the basis of:

1. Demonstrated aptitude for research
2. Academic achievement
