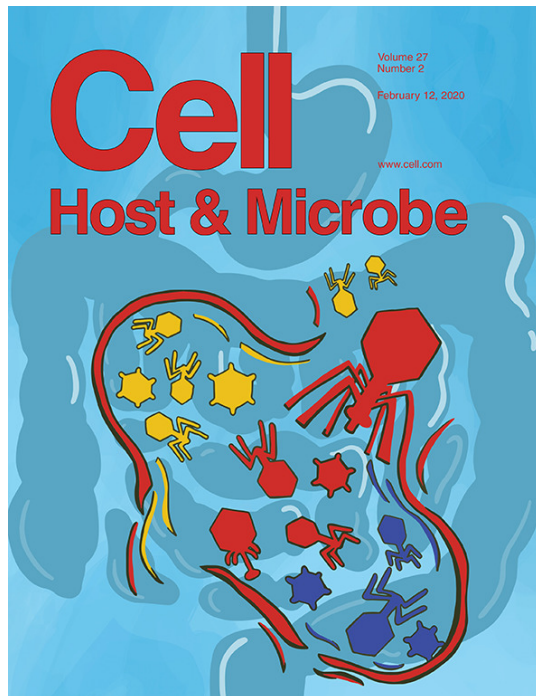
McGill24 is back on March 11 for its fifth annual day of giving at McGill!

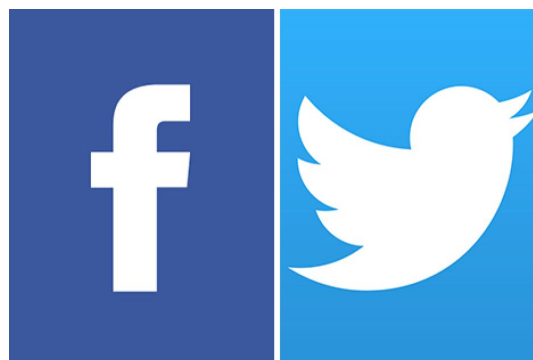
