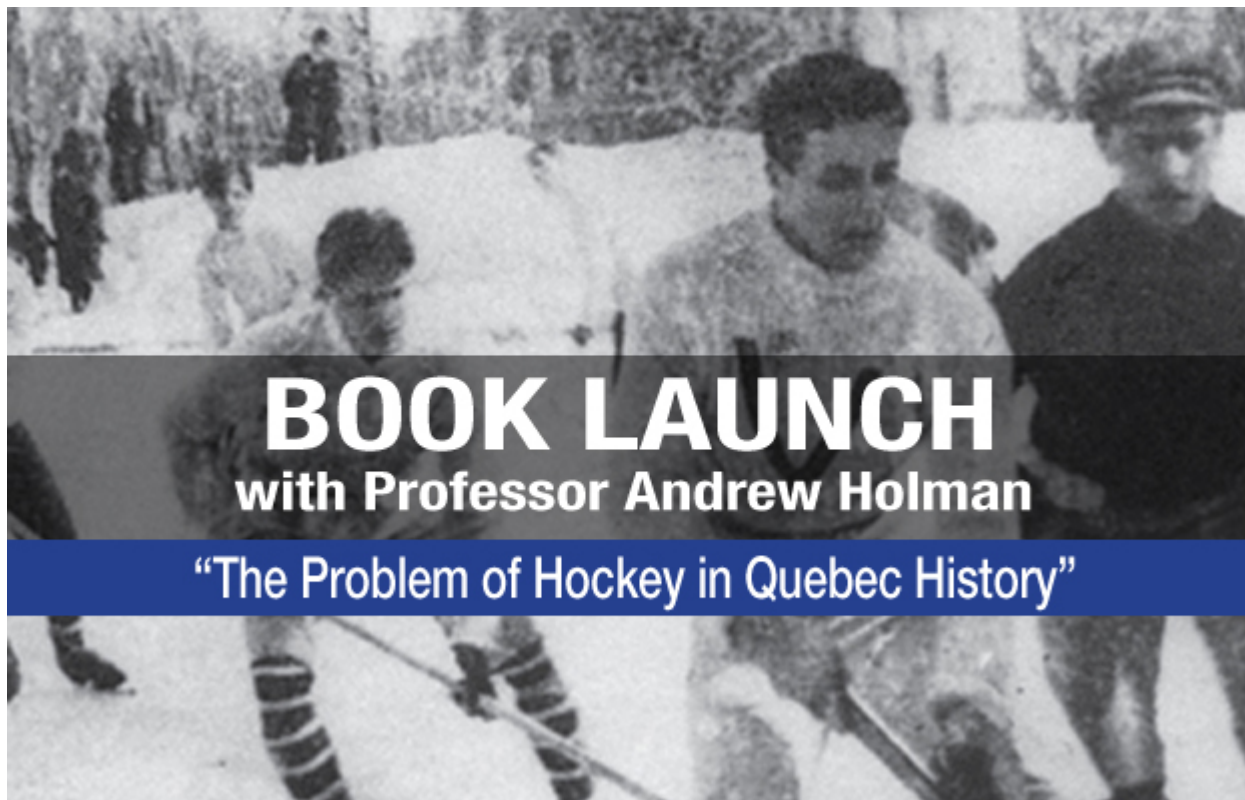

Book Launch: "The Problem of Hockey in Quebec History", presented by Professor Andrew Holman

Hockey has long been a popular pastime and a national obsession in Quebec, revealing much about Quebec and its relationship with the rest of Canada.
