Charles R. Bronfman and Alex K. Paterson Awards in Canadian Studies

Established in honour of Charles R. Bronfman and Alex K. Paterson, co-chairs of the McGill Institute for the Study of Canada's Board of Trustees from 1994 to 2008. These awards, valued at \$5,000 each, are awarded to doctoral students, whose research focuses on some aspect of Canada. Award holders may apply for a second year of funding, but their applications will be considered alongside those of individuals applying for a first-time award.

We invite Departments to recommend outstanding applicants whose name would be submitted into the competition.

Documents Required

1. The completed Nomination Form signed by the Applicant and the Chair/ Director of the Department at McGill where the applicant is, or intends to, register. For applications for award renewal, the thesis advisor should also sign the form;
2. One recent letter of recommendation by thesis advisor or department chair. Note that for award renewals, only the form above is required, although a letter is still recommended;
3. Description of the applicant's thesis/ research (maximum 3 pages). Note: if applying for a renewal, applicants will need to submit a progress report, which should be submitted with the nomination form;
4. Digital copies of official or certified copies (stamped and signed by the departmental representative) of all undergraduate and graduate transcripts, except for McGill transcripts, which may be informal and sent directly from the departmental representative;
5. Curriculum Vitae
