Course Credit & General Information

- All questions regarding string chamber music should be directed to Strings/Mixed Ensemble Chamber Music Coordinator (Prof. Jinjoo Cho), at <u>chamber.music@mcgill.ca</u>
- At Schulich, 1st-year <u>undergraduate</u> students are only assigned to one or less orchestra concert per semester in order to dedicate their first year to the art of string quartet playing. 1st-year undergraduate violinists, violists, and cellists are required to take the String Quartet Seminar (MUEN 565 2 credits) AS the large ensemble credit, in addition to the small ensemble coachings (MUEN 560 1 credit).
- **Contrabass/Harp/Guitar students** need faculty recommendations to participate in chamber music.
- Small Ensemble at Schulich is defined as a chamber music group with 3 or more players. **Sonata Duo Class is not a small ensemble credit for non-piano students.**
- String students may only participate in <u>one small ensemble per semester</u>. Some exceptions are granted for violists & cellists.
- String students <u>cannot participate in chamber music without credit</u> unless accompanied by a special request due to a specific situation. All requests need approval by Prof. Jinjoo Cho.
- If a student wishes to withdraw the small ensemble credit, he/she/they must consult with the assigned coach as well as Prof. Jinjoo Cho. Withdrawing from a small ensemble must not be taken lightly, as the decision affects all students assigned to the group.
- Per semester, small ensembles receive **11 hrs of coachings** per semester; and expected to rehearse at least **2 times** between coachings
 - String Ensembles will be assigned 1 coach per semester
 - Mixed Ensembles (groups that include piano or other non-string instruments) will be assigned 2 coaches per semester. The coaches will split the coachings hours.
 - 24 hrs notice is required to cancel a coaching for unavoidable reasons. Last-minute cancellations will not be made up.
- Marks are awarded by your coach based on preparation, progress, and final performance.

- **Final Performance** is required for all groups. All student groups must be available to perform on following dates:

Chamber Music Meeting & Group Assignments

- <u>ALL STRING STUDENTS</u> who wish to register for chamber music in 2021-22 school year <u>MUST</u> fill out the <u>Questionnaire Form</u> by SEP 2.
- <u>If this is your first semester at McGill</u>, please send a recorded sample of your solo playing (Free repertoire, minimum 5 minutes) to <u>chamber.music@mcgill.ca</u> by **SEP 2**.
- Pre-formed ensembles are encouraged.
- String Chamber Music Meeting attendance is <u>required</u> for all string students who wish to register for chamber music in 2021-22 school year. (Mask or Face Covering Mandatory)

Each Area has a different policy/procedure for small ensembles. <u>Even if you have a pre-formed mixed ensemble with string players, you must seek</u> <u>approval from your Area Coordinator, who will relay your requests to the Committee meeting</u> <u>among Area Coordinators.</u> PLEASE DO NOT SEND ANY REQUESTS TO <u>chamber.music@mcgill.ca</u>
- STRING STUDENTS: Pre-formed <u>MIXED</u> Ensembles
 - String students may submit their mixed-ensemble requests on the Questionnaire Form
 - Please note that **pianists** who are enrolled in Sonata Class cannot take chamber music
 - Please note that pre-formed mixed ensemble requests <u>are not guaranteed</u> and only granted if **ALL** Area Coordinators approve.
- STRING STUDENTS: Pre-formed <u>STRING</u> Ensembles
 - Pre-formed string ensembles require a minimum of 4 students in the group
- Groups will be formed and assigned a coach by Strings/Mixed Ensemble Chamber Music Coordinator, Prof. Jinjoo Cho, in conjunction with Area Coordinators and Chair of the Performance Department. Every effort is made to accommodate requests but the **final** assignment of ensembles and coaches is made by the Committee.

REGISTRATION TIMELINE

- The <u>PRELIMINARY</u> list of ensembles will be <u>emailed</u> by <u>September 4</u>. <u>DO NOT REGISTER BASED</u> <u>ON THIS PRELIMINARY LIST.</u> This list will include:
 - Your Name
 - Your Instrument
 - Your Email(s)
 - Your Group(s)
 - Your Assigned Coach
 - Your Repertoire
- Any requests for change can be <u>emailed</u> to <u>chamber.music@mcgill.ca</u> by **September 6**. Requests are given due consideration. However, the Strings/Mixed Ensemble Chamber Music Coordinator and/or the assigned coach will make the final decision.
- The **FINAL** list of groups/coaches/repertoire will be emailed by **September 8**. At this point, you may register. This list will include:
 - Your Name
 - Your Instrument
 - Your Emails(s)
 - Your Group(s) FINAL
 - Your Assigned Coach FINAL
 - Your Repertoire FINAL
 - Most importantly, your CRN, Course #, and Section # for registration *Students with two groups must look for two different CRN/course/section numbers
- CRNs, courses, sections will be open completely by **September 10**. Students must register for the correct course and section number on Minerva in order to avoid a failing grade and/or a late registration fee.
- First rehearsal/coaching should be scheduled AS SOON AS the final list of groups is released on **September 8th**. All students/coaches should have their first coaching scheduled by the end of Drop/Add, **Tuesday, September 14**.
