Les Percussions de Strasbourg 50th Anniversary Tour February 28, 2011

Montreal, February 7, 2011 – The Schulich School of Music and Innovations en concert are teaming up to bring Les Percussions de Strasbourg to Montreal, for their first appearance here since November 2000.

In Pollack Hall on February 28 at 8:00 p.m., they will perform a thrilling and diverse program, featuring Gérard Grisey's Tempus ex Machina, and three Montreal premieres: Andrew Staniland's Hex, Philippe Manoury's Livre des claviers, and Yoshihisa Taïra's Hierophonie V, each a commissioned work. Canadian composer Andrew Staniland's piece was commissioned by the ensemble especially for their current tour.

Under the leadership of artistic director Jean-Paul Bernard, the ensemble brings us this concert in celebration of their 50th anniversary. The six-member ensemble has commissioned hundreds of works, premiered over 250, and has forged the tradition of classical percussion repertoire as it is known today.

The first Western professional percussion ensemble, Les Percussions de Strasbourg are currently on a sixweek tour of North America, performing in Boston, Montreal, Albany, Toronto, San Francisco, Seattle and New York.

While in Montreal, Les Percussions de Strasbourg will also lead a free and open-to-the-public masterclass, featuring students in the percussion program of the Schulich School of Music on March 1, 2011 at 6:30 p.m. in Tanna Schulich Hall.
