In the case of a Special Project, assessment can take the form of one or more graded assessment tasks, at the discretion of the Special Project supervisor.

In accordance with the new McGill Assessment Policy, assessment of all Special Projects should be aligned with planned learning outcomes, and should be graded against a set of clearly defined criteria that are linked with those learning outcomes. Project supervisors should ensure that students understand what is required in relation to each of the criteria.
