## Yearly Program Study Plan; M.Mus. Performance; Organ (Thesis)

### Overview:

It is possible for a student to complete the program in 3 terms, but most students choose to complete the program in 4 terms.

Please note that your performance exams are considered the equivalent of a thesis. You do not have to submit a written thesis.

You should register for a minimum of 12 credits per term for the first three terms.

If you are doing a 9-credit exam in the first year, please register for MUPG 600 D1/D2 option which splits the credits between both terms.

Fees will be assessed at the "additional session" rate for the fourth term of studies.
