	<ol> <li>Wired Network migration: Upgrade of the wired telecom (wiring closet) equipment, including cabling, access switches, and power supply devices</li> <li>Wireless Network upgrade: Installation of new wireless access points, replacement and relocation of old access points</li> </ol>

## **SCHEDULE** CONT. Wireless Network Upgrade - Schedule There may be **sporadic** wireless interruptions in the specific areas of the building while IT technicians replace the wireless access points. **Dates** Floor **Wireless Connectivity:** Sporadic wireless interruptions may May 22 - July 20 inclusive All floors Onsite presence June 20 – Minimal Wired network service interruption IT technicians will be in the building on June 20 during business hours to connect each computer in the building. Minimal disruption (about 5 minutes per computer) is expected during this time. Date Floor Time **Downtime** 1 June 20 09h00 - 17h00 Up to 5 minutes per workstation REMINDER Before the date and time when Wired Migration on your floor, please log off but do not shut down (power off) your computers or devices. All non-used workstation should be turned on if possible. This will allow us to validate that they are reconnected properly to the network after the migration. WHO IS **AFFECTED** The entire University will receive the Network Upgrade over the next three years.
