- Supports supervisors and students in the clinical setting through regular visits as well as by email, myCourses, and/or by telephone as required.
- Supports supervisors in relation to teaching/learning principles, enhancing clarification of course objectives, student assessment, and relevant university policies/procedures.
- Works with the unit/clinic leadership to promote the best student learning experience possible.
- Promotes and facilitates the development of competencies in students through learning activities such as case presentations, journal article reviews, etc.
- Participates in relevant Simulation activities as requested by the Course Coordinator
- Answers student and supervisor questions in a timely manner.
- Promptly communicates any concerns related to student learning to the course coordinator and/or Program Director as appropriate.
- Works with the course coordinator to develop and implement a learning plan for students experiencing difficulties in the clinical setting.
- Support supervisors in completing clinical evaluations and reviews/discusses with course coordinator as needed.
- Attends meetings with course coordinator as required.

Please note that given the current circumstances, this course may be taught remotely/online. Or a combination of in-person clinical and remotely. The Clinical Instructor will be required to deliver teaching material suited to a remote/online teaching environment using a virtual learning platform [e.g., Zoom, WebEx] and the McGill MyCourses learning management system. Training and assistance on

remote teaching is available through Teaching and Learning Services. It may be possible that some aspects of this course will be offered in person and/or using tele-health.
