UPDATED Abstract preparation guidelines:

- Maximum word count: 350 words (excluding spaces)
- The title of the abstract and author(s) are not included in the 350 words
- Language of submission: English or French
- Required headings: introduction, methods, results, conclusion
- Additionally, please include a brief explanation of how your topic fits into the theme of the conference
- **Abstracts can have been published or presented at any other conference (please specify) within the past year**

Additional information:

- Abstracts should be submitted only if an author intends to attend the conference and present the poster if accepted
- All presenters must register for the conference and pay the appropriate registration fee
- Designated poster session times will be listed in the Conference Program. Presenting authors will be required to stand by their posters during listed time(s)
- Instructions regarding the poster presentation will be provided if the abstract is accepted
- Abstracts must be submitted by email with the subject: “Nursing Explorations 2018: Call for Abstracts Submission” and sent to: conference.nursing@mcgill.ca

Abstract submission themes:

- ***Together Stronger: Nurses Shaping Future Environments for Health*** is a theme that may have many dimensions including but not limited to: nursing politics and activism; nursing and technology: implications for clinical practice; education and research; ethical dimensions of nursing; social justice and equity; culture of healthcare; workplace environment and quality of care; Indigenous health; environmental health
