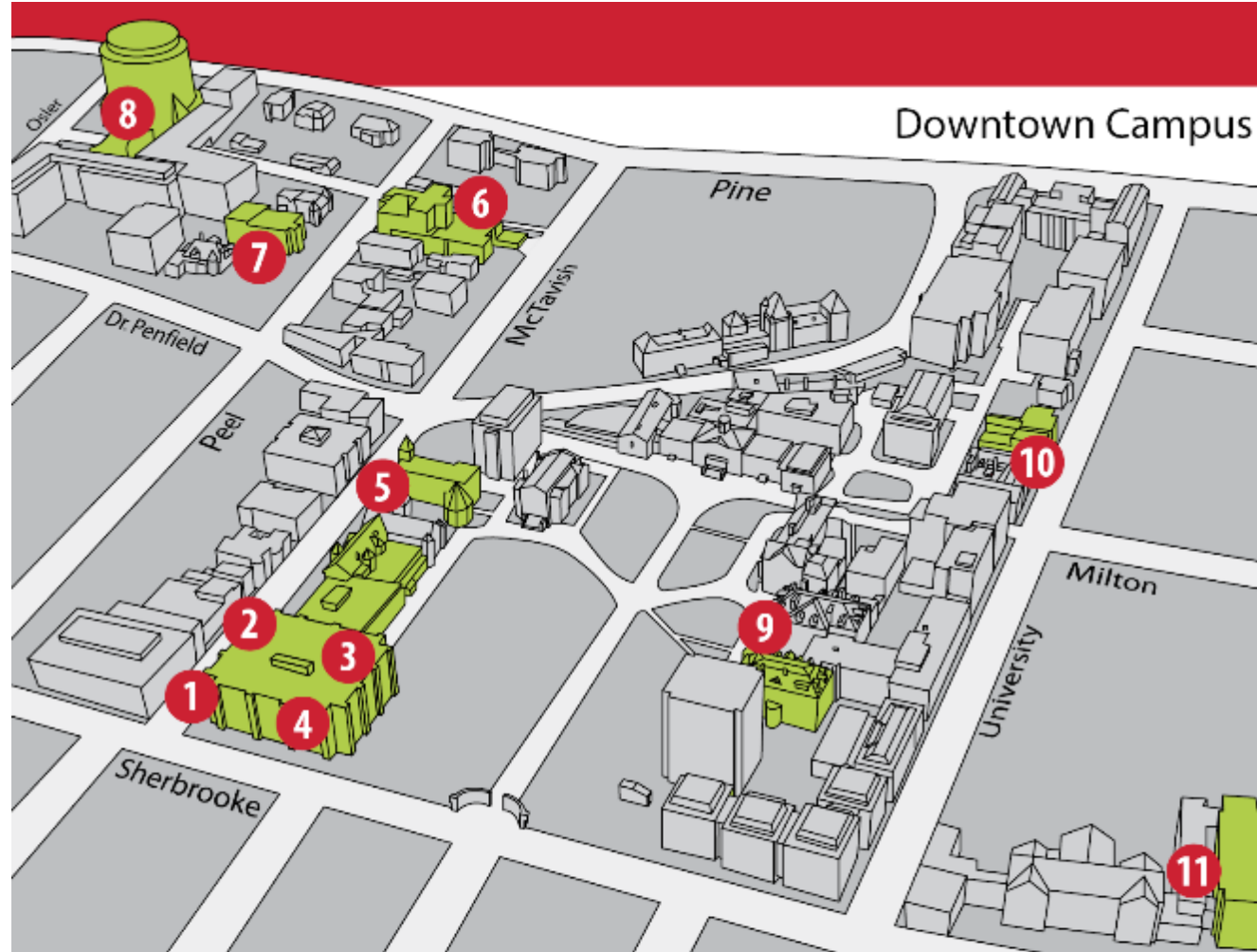

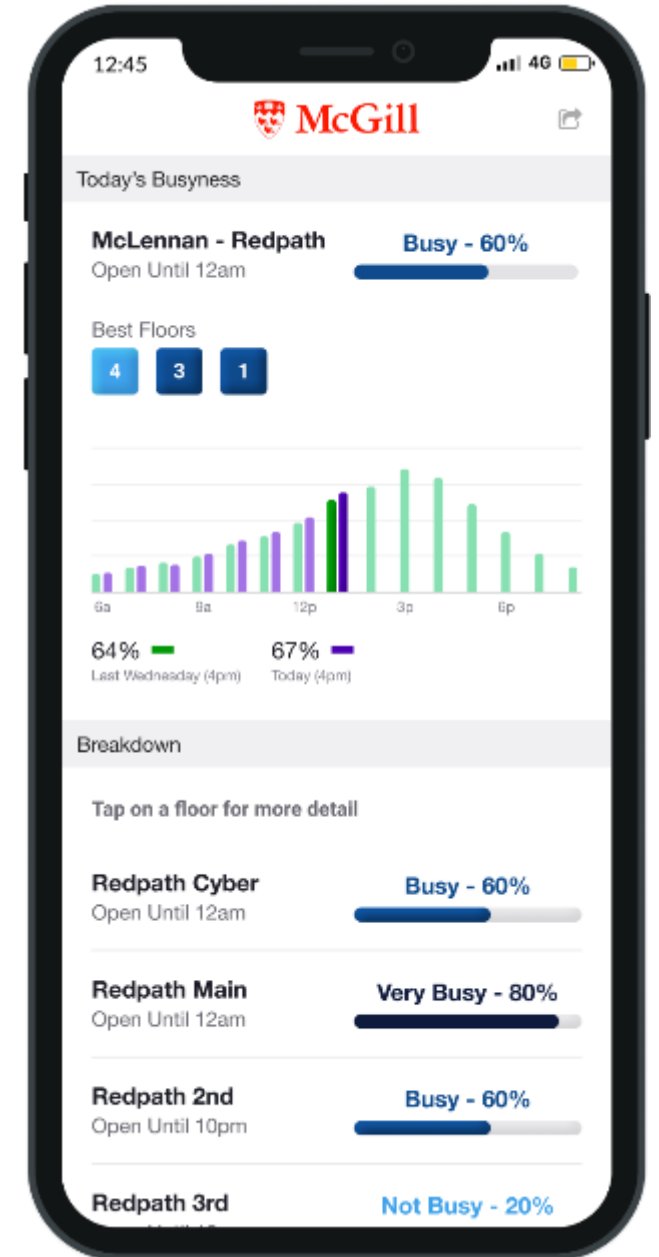
Skip the Waitz
