Evolution of the Pandemic in ISON

Acute Phase of Wave 1

- Students travel home and quickly adjust to new ways of learning/studying;
- Faculty and staff set up their homes as workspaces;
- Faculty revise their courses;
- Clinical Partnerships Office negotiate summer placements with partners.

Post-Acute Wave 1

- Student, faculty and staff continue to adjust to new ways of working/learning;
- Faculty plan fall courses and remote delivery;
- Clinical Partnerships Office negotiate fall placements with partners;
- Lab faculty and staff resume work in 680 Sherbrooke.

Acute Phase of Wave 2

- Faculty are planning winter 2021 course delivery;
- Students, faculty and staff adjust to the new social distancing restrictions.

Students, faculty and staff cope with illness and loss of loved ones.

Winter 2021

- All clinical and lab courses will continue to be held in person;
- Some clinical courses will continue with block scheduling, but not all. More information will be available in the coming weeks;
- ISoN will continue to waive the clinical requirements of **safeTALK** and **mask fitting**;
- The flu shot remains a clinical requirement.
