- Orients self to the assigned Clinical Placement Site/Agency in advance as a means of preparing the way for student arrival and clinical learning; includes all mandatory 'On-boarding' requirements.
- Teaches and directly supervises a group of students in fulfilling the course objectives, includes select/assign one Older Adult per student; facilitate experiences with older adults and their families (can be via Zoom).
- Actively contributes to student learning through planned lectures, Lab and Simulation activities at the School of Nursing in September via zoom
- Supports student learning by applying Strengths Based Nursing (SBN) philosophy, principles and approaches to teaching and learning; models essential SBN qualities.
- Organizes and leads student group clinical debriefing conferences at end of clinical shift or via Zoom.
- Monitors and documents students' learning in relation to 234 course objectives and related clinical skills throughout the course; using course tools. Provides Midterm/formative and Final Clinical Performance Assessment findings and decision to students.
- Meets with course coordinator to orient to the course objectives and processes; communicates with the course coordinator about students' progress and any concerns related to student learning.
- Works with the clinical site leadership and advocates to promote conditions that support student learning and experience. Reports any concerns in timely manner to Course Coordinator.
- Accesses MyCourses regularly and communicates with the Course Coordinator or students by email as necessary.
