- Organizes and leads group clinical conferences (in-person or online).
- Sustains ongoing dialogue about learning strengths and challenges, as well as what promotes or hinder learning throughout the course.
- Reinforces clinical practice, in conjunction with post-conference teaching/debriefing, case studies, reflective practice, and self-evaluation to enhance breadth and depth of critical thinking and clinical decision-making throughout the course.
- Provides formative and summative evaluation to students including documenting the students’ learning throughout the course.
- Meets with course coordinators to review course objectives; communicates with the course coordinator about any concerns related to student learning.
- Works with the clinical unit leadership to promote the best student learning experience possible.
- Accesses MyCourses regularly and communicates with students by email as necessary.
