JOB DESCRIPTION & OTHER INFORMATION
<p>In this clinical course, students will apply the guiding principles and values of primary health care through the application of the community health nursing process using capacity building and strength-based approach in partnership with populations and communities outside the health care system leading to a health promotion project.</p> <p>The instructor is responsible for 6 to 8 student teams (5-7 students/team) and supports each team in the development and implementation of a community-based project. The instructor follows the teams' progression, meets each team at least twice during the semester and as needed, ensures team-building development to address any issues that arise (e.g., conflict). They may be required to travel to community-based organizations partnering with student teams a minimum of twice during the semester and as needed, and be present when student teams implement projects in the community (TBD based on Public Health Pandemic Guidelines at the time). The instructor prepares and conducts online conferences, grades team and individual assignments, and grades team presentations done in remote classes. They may also meet remotely with the course coordinator and co-teachers to finalize</p>

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grading. The instructor acts as a resource person for the community-based organizations and supports them by answering their questions and concerns regarding the project or team behavior as needed and refers to the course coordinator as needed for any team issues. They also support the course coordinator to build, create, change assignments or evaluations as needed, and must stay in communication with all the colleagues teaching this course throughout the term.
