- Attends Orientation to course (may be virtual) prior to start of clinical rotation. Date to be determined.
- Responsible for selection/assignment of patient/s.
- Provides formative and summative evaluation of students' clinical performance, including documenting the students' progress throughout the course.
- Communicates with the course coordinator any concerns related to student learning.
- Participates in end of course debrief.
- Teaches and directly supervises a group of students in fulfilling the course objectives (includes in-person and may include remote clinical teaching, orientation, and simulation; or preceptor-support)
- Supports student learning by assessing the student's learning style and providing the appropriate teaching strategy.
- Organizes and leads group clinical conferences.
- Provides formative and summative evaluation to students including documenting the students' learning throughout the course.
- Works with the clinical unit leadership to promote the best student learning experience possible.
- Accesses MyCourses regularly and communicates with students by email as necessary.
- Participates in relevant labs/SIM if required.
