The incumbent will be responsible for the preparation of all course materials, teaching/facilitation of classes, coordination of learning activities, and student assessments for the neonatal NP pharmacology course and for a portion of the pediatric, primary care and adult care NP pharmacology courses.

For the other portion of the pediatric and primary care NP pharmacology courses, the course lecturer will coordinate with the Nurse Director/Assistant Nurse Director of the respective concentrations to invite guest lecturers to teach concentration-specific content.

The course lecturer is also responsible for creating and maintaining the courses in the student learning management system (myCourses) and for uploading student grades to the University's central information system (Minerva)
