JOB DESCRIPTION & OTHER INFORMATION
<p>Community care clinical stream. Students will be exploring the community care nursing and solidifying their competencies, assessments and interventions with families in communities in one the community networks/clinics. Students will be placed into one 3 blocks, each block is 4 days a week for 4 weeks. Clinical days are Monday-Tuesday-Wednesday-Friday.</p> <p>Block 1: Sept 13-Oct 8 Block 2: Oct 12-Nov 5</p>

Block 3: Nov 8 – Dec 3

Preceptor support hires will provide support and advising to students' preceptors and students as necessary. They will be involved in the student assessment process and apply McGill University Ingram School of Nursing clinical policies and procedures and follow the course outline in their follow up with students and preceptors. Depending on the current COVID protocols and restrictions, some of the work may be done remotely via Zoom.

Role Expectations:

- Support preceptors and students (approximately 25 dyads) in the clinical setting (multiple sites) through visits to clinical settings as well as by email, myCourses, or telephone as needed.
- Support clinical preceptors in relation to teaching/learning principles, enhancing clarification of course objectives, student evaluation, and relevant university policies/procedures.
- Answer student and preceptor questions in a timely manner
- Support preceptors in completing clinical performance assessment as needed and review/discuss with course coordinator as needed
- Promote a healthy learning environment
