Freshman Program Regulations to Remember

The Freshman Program consists of 24 - 30 credits, including 18 credits of Core Courses
Core Courses for your Freshman Program must be passed with a grade of "C" or better
Courses in U0 cannot be taken under the Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory grading option
Courses in U0 should be selected from the Approved Freshman Courses list
The normal course load per term is 4 - 5 courses (12 - 15 credits)
You must have completed any prerequisites listed in the course description
You may not register for courses which are scheduled to meet at the same time
