NOTES:

1. **UPDATE: OASIS does not permit ISA to institutions currently listed as exchange partners (except during the summer term).**
2. All exchange and independent study away must be pre-approved by Arts OASIS to determine if you meet the [academic eligibility requirements](#) to receive "Faculty Approval" on your Minerva application and transfer credits.
3. **McGILL EXCHANGE:**
 - a. If you apply and accept a nomination to a McGill Exchange partner, your status at the host institution will be "exchange/non-degree" student. **A list of exchange partners is available [here](#).**
 - b. Many of our McGill Exchange partners do not accept applications for "Independent Study Away" undergraduate "visiting, non-degree" student status.
4. **INDEPENDENT STUDY AWAY:** Although a university appears on this listing, it is your responsibility (**not Arts OASIS**) to confirm:
 - a. The university has an undergraduate "visiting/non-degree" student status;
 - b. You meet the host country's visa requirements and the host university's eligibility criteria;
 - c. You meet their application requirements and can afford the university's tuition.
