Dr. Pratz is a clinical investigator of novel therapeutics for acute leukemias and is an Associate Professor of Medicine and Director of Leukemia Program at the Abramson Cancer Center at University of Pennsylvania in Philadelphia. He is the principal investigator on clinical trials incorporating novel targeted therapies into combination chemotherapy in acute leukemia. Dr. Pratz is also active in designing, coordinating, and conducting laboratory correlative studies in the setting of investigational therapies to aid in the development of improved treatments for hematologic malignancies.
