**Eugene Rogala, M.D., C.M., FRCSC**  
**1941 – 1981**

Dr. Eugene Rogala was born and educated in Montreal, being a graduate of Loyola College. He obtained his degree M.D., C.M. from McGill University in 1966 and completed his training in Orthopaedic Surgery at the Royal Victoria Hospital. Further training in Pediatric Orthopaedics and Spinal Surgery was done from 1971-1973 as a McLaughlin Traveling Fellow in Toronto, Boston, Wilmington and Edinburgh prior to his return to Montreal.

As director of Clinical Services at the Shriners Hospital, he was instrumental in the development of an extensive school screening program for the detection of scoliosis and authored a landmark reference on the incidence and natural history of these deformities. He was also responsible for the development of important and lasting principles in the correction of deformities in rachitic children. His interests in spinal surgery led him to many individual and collaborative efforts with colleagues in the care of patients.

A dedicated researcher and teacher, Eugene Rogala was a gentleman with an enormous enthusiasm for life and living. He was above all, a caring physician worthy of emulation.

**James Roach, M.D.**

Dr. James Roach was born in Norfolk, VA. He graduated in Medicine from Georgetown University, Washington, DC. and completed his orthopaedic training at the Tripler Army Medical Center in Honolulu, HI.

Following his residency, he completed a pediatric orthopaedic fellowship at the Texas Scottish Rite Hospital in Dallas, Texas. He served as a Major in the United States Army during his residency & fellowship years.

He later completed a Masters in Business Administration at Duke University in Durham, NC.

Dr. Roach is currently Professor of Orthopaedic Surgery at the University of Utah, Salt Lake City & Visiting Professor of Orthopaedic Surgery at the University of Pittsburgh, Pittsburgh, PA

He is a pediatric orthopaedic surgeon at the Children's Hospital of Pittsburgh & Assistant Chief of Staff at the Shriners Hospital, Erie, PA.

Dr. Roach has achieved honors from the Alpha Omega Honor Society . He is a reviewer of four prestigious orthopaedic journals. He has numerous publications and is involved in Research. He has responsibilities in numerous professional and scientific societies and is immediate past President of POSNA.
