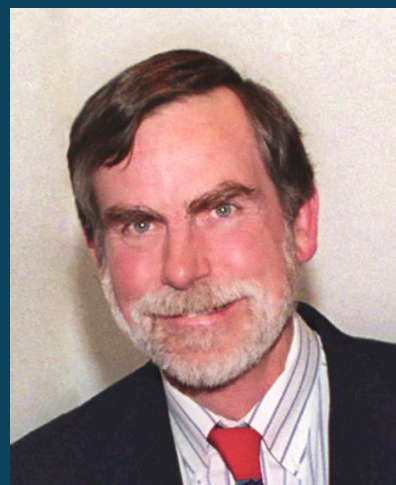

**Eugene Rogala, M.D., C.M., FRCS(C)**  
**1941 – 1981**

Dr. Eugene Rogala was born and educated in Montreal, being a graduate of Loyola College. He obtained his degree M.D., C.M. from McGill University in 1966 and completed his training in Orthopedic Surgery at the Royal Victoria Hospital. Further training in Pediatric Orthopedics and Spinal Surgery was done from 1971-1973 as a McLaughlin Traveling Fellow in Toronto, Boston, Wilmington and Edinburgh prior to his return to Montreal.

As director of Clinical Services at the Shriners Hospital, he was instrumental in the development of an extensive school screening program for the detection of scoliosis and authored a landmark reference on the incidence and natural history of these deformities. He was also responsible for the development of important and lasting principles in the correction of deformities in rachitic children. His interests in spinal surgery led him to many individual and collaborative efforts with colleagues in the care of patients.

A dedicated researcher and teacher, Eugene Rogala was a gentleman with an enormous enthusiasm for life and living. He was above all, a caring physician worthy of emulation.

**Dr Charles E. Johnston**

Charles E Johnston MD (“Charlie”) is assistant chief of staff emeritus at Texas Scottish Rite Hospital for Children, where he has practiced continuously since 1985. A native of Southern California with family ties to south Texas, he graduated from Yale University and Columbia University College of Physicians and Surgeons, completed a surgical internship in San Antonio, and orthopedic surgery residency at the University of Virginia Medical Center in Charlottesville. He returned to Texas as a Harrington Fellow in Pediatric Orthopaedics and Scoliosis at TSRH in Dallas in 1981-2 (fellowship had no relationship to Dr. Paul R. Harrington).

Dr. Johnston is currently Professor in the Department of Orthopaedic Surgery at the University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center at Dallas. He is a reviewer for the Journal of Bone and Joint Surgery and the Journal of Children’s Orthopaedics. He is a fellow in the American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons and serves on the executive committee of the Pediatric Spine Study Group and Foundation. An active member of the Scoliosis Research Society since 1987, he has served on and chaired several committees, currently serving on the Education and Growing Spine committees, and is the 2021 Harrington lecturer. He is also a member of the Pediatric Orthopedic Society of North America, receiving its Humanitarian Award in 2020; the European Pediatric Orthopaedic Society; and the Texas Orthopedic Association.

Dr. Johnston has published over 150 papers in peer-reviewed journals and approximately 30 books chapters. He has been an invited faculty or visiting professor at national and international institutions on 60 occasions.

Most important, Charlie and Ellen have been married for 45 years, have two daughters and five grandchildren.

It is our privilege to have Dr. Johnston as our 36th Eugene Rogala Visiting Professor.
