

General Biosafety Questionnaire for Core Facility – Institute of Parasitology, McGill

The Core Facility operates as a multi-user facility where many different samples from various sources that may contain known or unknown human pathogens are investigated live. Information about sample sources and potentially infectious agents is critical for effective biosafety measures.
