Tenure-track positions in Parasitology: The Institute of Parasitology at McGill University (http://www.mcgill.ca/parasitology/) seeks to fill two tenure-track positions; the first is at the level of Associate Professor/Full Professor and the second is at level of Assistant Professor. Candidates holding a PhD or equivalent with demonstrated success in research excellence, and potential for high quality teaching in the broad area of Molecular Parasitology or Immunoparasitology are invited to submit their applications. The appointee at the rank of Associate Professor/Full Professor should have a track record commensurate with an appointment as a Tier I Canada Research Chair (http://www.chairs-chaires.gc.ca/home-accueil-eng.aspx). We seek applicants with a history of excellent and impactful publications and successful achievements in securing extramural research funding. Applications are encouraged from scientists working on parasite systems of veterinary and human importance, in particular with research programs focusing on molecular or immunological aspects of parasitology. The appointees are expected to develop a competitive research program supported by external funding and will participate in undergraduate and graduate teaching within the Faculty of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences. The Faculty of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences (http://www.mcgill.ca/macdonald/) and McGill University have a large and dynamic community of researchers focused on parasitic infections. including genomics, proteomics, imaging, drug research and clinical applications provide outstanding opportunities to establish multidisciplinary collaborative projects. Quebec's prominent and interactive community of parasitologists, who are members of the Centre for Host-Parasite Interactions, provides attractive possibilities to develop new research linkages.
