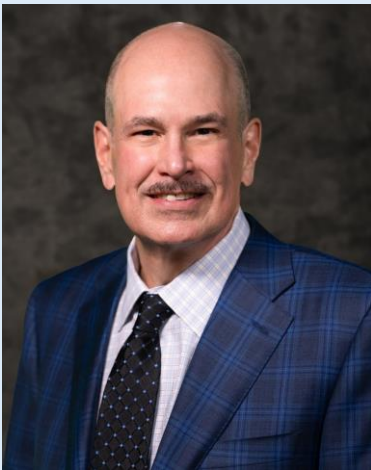




Seminar Announcement (Hybrid)

Dr. John Hart, MD

Professor and Vice Chair of Anatomic Pathology
University of Chicago Medicine
Department of Pathology



Dr. John Hart joined the faculty of the University of Chicago Department of Pathology as an Assistant Professor in 1991, rose to the rank of Full Professor in 2004, and became Vice Chair for Anatomic Pathology in 2023. He initiated the GI & Hepatic pathology fellowship, which to date has graduated 30 GI pathologists who are now working in leading academic pathology departments throughout the United States and Canada. Dr. Hart has published more than 250 articles in the fields of gastrointestinal and hepatic pathology. He has lectured throughout the United States and in Europe, the Middle East, and Asia. He is a past president of the United States and Canadian Academy of Pathology and of the Rodger Haggitt Gastrointestinal Pathology Society.
