	Problem solving and patient management skills	
	Communication skills	
	Response to feedback	
	Working relationships and how the applicant worked in a team	
	Professionalism (i.e. motivation, punctuality, sense of responsibility) as related to clinical duties and research projects	
	Specific qualities and unique contributions
