



Fellowship Scholarship for Canadian and International Students

The McGill University Department of Psychiatry is glad to announce that it will be offering one to three new scholarships to support postgraduate training in any of the department's currently available fellowship programs. These departmentally funded scholarships allow selected candidates to further their knowledge and acquire expertise in their field of concentration.

The scholarships will cover salary, tuition and applicable service fees up to a maximum amount of \$53,500 per year.

To be eligible for a scholarship, applicants to the Psychiatry Fellowship Program must fall under one of the following categories:

- ▮ Graduates of Canadian medical schools (non-Quebec)
- ▮ International medical doctors who are graduates of medical schools listed in the [FAIMER directory](#) and who are not Canadian citizens or permanent residents of Canada

All applicants must have successfully completed a residency program in psychiatry or its equivalent by the time they start their fellowship.

Interested applicants must qualify for and apply to a Psychiatry Fellowship program (<https://mcgill.ca/pgme/programs/fellowship-programs>). To determine your application route please visit [Postgraduate and Medical Education - How to Apply](#).

Furthermore, applicants must also send a personal statement to Dr. Ruben Martins, fellowship and mentorship director (ruben.martins@mcgill.ca).

In your statement, include comments on the following:

1. your clinical experience to date
2. the reasons you wish to receive the scholarship
3. the reasons you wish to apply for the fellowship
4. the reasons to choose McGill University as your training environment
5. your post-training career objectives, including your goals for research, teaching and clinical work.

Selection Process:

Applicants must first apply through the Postgraduate Medical Education Office by September 1, 2022, as stated in the link above, and send their personal statement to Dr. Martins. After the application process is completed, all files (including personal statements) will be reviewed by the fellowship director and a scholarship selection committee. Then, the best applicants will be contacted for an interview (October 2022) with the members of the scholarship selection committee.

The selection committee will choose up to three applicants among the most deserving based on different criteria (medical expert, communicator, scholar, collaborator, professional, leader, health advocate and personal motivation).
